



#### **About Whole Person Education**

Whole person education in higher education emphasizes the holistic development of students, acknowledging that intellectual growth is interconnected with emotional, social, spiritual and ethical dimensions. The primary objective of whole person education includes cultivating critical thinking skills, fostering emotional intelligence, promoting ethical decision-making, and nurturing a sense of social responsibility. The approach also endorses diverse range of pedagogic and evaluation practices towards growth and development of students for success in a rapidly changing world. The whole person education approach can be adopted as part of the ethos of colleges or Universities. It can also be practiced by educators in their classrooms. The approach has implications for every stakeholder in education and opens avenues to foster all round development.

## **About the University**

The University being multidisciplinary focuses on teaching, research and service, offering Programmes to about 27,000 students from all the states and union territories of India and 77 other countries.

CHRIST (Deemed to be University) began as Christ College in 1969, offering undergraduate programmes

CHRIST (Deemed to be University) is ranked 67 in the NIRF – 2023. As per India Today Ranking 2023, almost all departments have ranked within 10 for various parameters. In the QS Asia University rankings, the University has performed among the top 86% and ranked 39 for Fourth Industrial Revolution in World University Ranking for Innovation (WURI).

## The Teaching Learning Enhancement Cell (TLEC)

The Teaching Learning Enhancement Cell (TLEC) at CHRIST (Deemed to be University) works towards enhancing the quality of curricula and teaching-learning-assessment practices at the University. In the present scenario, given the emphasis by the Ministry of Education, University Grants Commission, National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) and the National Board of Accreditation (NBA) on the adoption of a Learning Outcome-based Curriculum Framework (LOCF) and the focus on formative assessment, TLEC attend to the need for such an initiative in a higher education teaching, learning, and assessment. CHRIST (Deemed to be University) is proud to be one of the pioneers to address this gap through institutional mechanisms. The primary mission of the Teaching Learning Enhancement Cell is to support the Departments and the faculty of the University in enhancing the quality of curricula and teaching-learning-assessment practices within the framework of the emphasis of the University on holistic education and development.

## **Pre-Training Workshop - Day 1 (Online)**

Day one of the Workshop is being planned online to enable participants to prepare for the offline workshop. The facilitators will introduce participants to various models of conceptualising and adopting Whole Person Education followed by institutions worldwide. This orientation will equip participants to reflect on the practices followed in their institutions and identify one they consider their best practice.

The session includes an introduction to WPE and a sharing of workshop details, agenda, outcomes, and materials to work on. The facilitators will provide reading materials and a framework for asynchronous work, which participants must engage with and bring back while attending the offline training workshop.

## Training Workshop: Day 2 and Day 3 (Offline)

The two-day offline workshop is being conceptualized to enable faculty members to review their institutional vision and mission and streamline the best practices they currently employ at their own institutions. The workshop will support participants in mapping their activities and other engagements at their institutions to their definitions of Whole Person Education along with their Vision and Mission. The participants will design a road map to strengthen their practices as an outcome of this workshop.
