## Background of the Seminar

The Indian higher education system is currently undergoing a major systemic shift in terms of policy changes. The national, state and local focus on universities and colleges are challenged to refocus themselves to re-evaluate their goals, policies and practices in terms of offering degrees, carrying out research, and innovations besides contributing to society as facilitators of a meaningful educational experience. Institutions are therefore challenged to carefully evaluate the behaviours and practices that would benefit to evolve new strategies.

In recent years, Indian accreditation process and global ranking have become exceedingly critical and rigorous in the context of an institution's preparedness and performance concerning accreditation and ranking practices. On the other side, institutions give little importance to accreditation and ranking preparedness from a holistic and organizational perspective. Despite many criticisms, accreditation and ranking systems are influential. It has a strong impact on academic decision-making and behaviour, and on the structure of institutions.

Hence the National Seminar on Preparedness for Performance: Self Evaluation of Universities and Colleges is designed to prepare the universities and colleges to go through a process of self-reflection to enhance both faculty and departmental preparedness for accreditation and ranking. The Seminar will also enable the university to prepare to meet the expected levels of compliance to accreditation standards and ranking preparedness by developing a holistic approach towards the accreditation process.



## The University

CHRIST (Deemed to be University) was born out of the educational vision of St Kuriakose Elias Chavara, an educationalist and social reformer of the nineteenth century in South India. He founded the first Catholic indigenous congregation, Carmelites of Mary Immaculate (CMD), in 1831 which administers CHRIST (Deemed to be University).

CHRIST (Deemed to be University) was established as 'Christ College' in 1969. It undertook path-breaking initiatives in Indian higher education with the introduction of innovative and modern curricula, insistence on academic discipline, imparting of Holistic Education and adoption of global higher education practices with the support of creative and dedicated staff."

The University Grants Commission (UGC) of India conferred Autonomy to Christ College in 2004 and identified it as an Institution with Potential for Excellence in 2006. In 2008 under Section 3 of the UGC Act, 1956, the Ministry of Human Resource Development of the Government of India, declared the institution a Deemed to be University, in the name and style of Christ University. One of the first institutions in India to be accredited in 1998 by the NAAC, and subsequently in 2004 and 2016, CHRIST (Deemed to be University) has the top grade 'A' in the 4-point scale.

The multi-disciplinary University which focuses on teaching research and service offers Bachelor, Master and Doctoral programmes in humanities, social sciences, sciences, commerce, management, engineering, architecture, education, and law to about 25000 students. The University offers its programmes at three campus locations in Bangalore in Karnataka; and in Pune Lavasa in Maharashtra and Delhi NCR.

The campus is a living example of harmonious multiculturalism with students from all the states and union territories and around 60 different countries. CHRIST (Deemed to be University) publishes six peer-reviewed research journals and has published more than 300 books in Kannada and English. A promoter of sports, music and literary activities, it is a nurturing ground for creative excellence.

## Centre for Education Beyond Curriculum (CEDBEC)

The Centre has been conceived as an attempt to stimulate and rediscover through experience, the perspectives in education so that individuals and institutions reflect and rediscover themselves and move towards a sustainable progress in the educational arena.
